Namibia's Coast: Rugged and wild with the Atlantic Ocean on one side and the dunes of the Namib on the other side. There are two major towns at Namibia's coast: The harbor town Walvis Bay, where flights arrive from South Africa on a daily basis and often luxury cruises stop for a visit and Swakopmund, Namibia's premier holiday resort, with plenty of excursions are offered, for the adventurer or the keen photographer. We recommend a stay of at least 2 nights in order to explore this destination.

Walvis Bay - Swakopmund

Day 1: Walvis Bay. Arrival in Walvis Bay at around 13:00 (for example from your flight ex Cape Town or from the tour 'Sossusvlei Shuttle'). Transfer to your Hotel at the beautiful lagoon in Walvis Bay (for your budget version: the Courtyard Hotel and for your superior version: the Pelican Bay Hotel) Overnight on a bed and breakfast basis.

Day 2: Walvis Bay - Swakopmund. After breakfast you may walk to the nearby Yacht Club. From there you may join a boat-trip on a catamaran boat (the boat trip is included only for the superior option, it is optional for the budget version). This will take you all the way to the 'Pelican Point' and with a bit of luck dolphins and seals will accompany your trip. From here you will be able to enjoy the beautiful bay of Walvis Bay with a prolific bird life. On board snacks and a small variety of beverages will be served. At around lunchtime you will return to the pier. You'll be picked up from your hotel in Walvis Bay and transferred to Swakopmund. Relax during the course of the afternoon at the beach or go shopping in this coastal holiday resort. Accommodation on a bed and breakfast basis in the Hansa Hotel or similar on your superior version and the Pension Rapmund on your budget version.

Day 3: Swakopmund. Participate in a half-day morning desert excursion (this is included in your superior version and optional with your budget version). The tour is conducted in a small group with a knowledgeable guide and leads to the moonlandscape, the Swakop riverbed, the Oasis Goanikontes and also the endemic and ancient plant, the Welwitschia Mirabilis. Return to Swakopmund at around 13h00.
