Etosha Safari

Windhoek - Etosha National Park - Windhoek
Tuesdays: 4 days/3 nights

Day 1: Windhoek – Etosha National Park.

(app. 420 km tarred road – app. 5 hours driving time)

Your experienced safari-guide will fetch you from your hotel in Windhoek and you depart at around 08h30 from Windhoek towards Okahandja, via Outjo into the famous Etosha National Park, where we'll undertake our first game drives. (lunch enroute excluded) The Park is well known for its huge herds of antelope and zebra.

Overnight with dinner, bed and breakfast at Okaukuejo or Halali Resort inside the Park (subject to availability) or one of the privately owned lodges just outside the Andersson's Gate.

Day 2: Etosha National Park.

A full day in the Park lies ahead of us. Except for the rainy season, Etosha's animals are depending on artificial waterholes and natural springs. Explore the various waterholes along this enormous saltpan. Lunch stop at one of the resorts (lunch excluded). Encounter the big variety of wildlife in the Park during the course of the morning. More than 114 mammal species are found in the Park, several of them are rare and endangered like the black rhino and the black faced impala. You have a great chance of seeing some of the bigger mammals, like elephant and rhino and of course a highlight in any safari, the predators.

Overnight with dinner, bed and breakfast at Okaukuejo or Halali (subject to availability) or one of the privately owned lodges just outside the Andersson's Gate.

Day 3: Etosha National Park.

Another full day in the Park lies ahead of us. We will drive along the vast saltpan, which is called the "great white place of dry water" in a local language. In some years, after heavy rain falls, thousands of flamingos come from the coast for breeding. The pan is also rich in minerals and offers a great nutritious supplement to the all the animals. It attracts herds of antelopes and the predators that follow their prey.

Overnight with dinner, bed and breakfast at Namutoni Resort (if available) or one of the privately owned lodges just outside the Van Lindequist Gate.

Day 4: Etosha National Park – Windhoek.

(app. 420 km tarred road – app. 5 hours driving time)

Lunch stop at Tsumeb or Otjiwarongo (lunch excl.) and return to Windhoek, where we shall arrive at around 17:00.

End of Etosha Safari

Included:

Tour in a private group 4 to 6 passengers with an English and/or German speaking safari in a 4x4 Landcruiser or Gameviewer safari vehicle.

Accommodation and meals: 3x overnight, 3x breakfast, 0x lunch, 3x dinner.

Excursions: Game-drives inside the Etosha National Park in the African Extravaganza vehicle.

Extras: Park-entrance-fees, portorage, still and sparkling water on board the vehicle.

Excluded:

Any additional excursions or activities (e.g. night drives offered by Nature Conservation), all lunches, beverages, tips, personal insurances and other personal items are excluded.
